In an effort to safeguard and promote your loved ones' optimal health and well-being, the Seasons is following the most aggressive interventions within its abilities that have been recommended by healthcare providers. At present, physician offices, hospitals including emergency rooms, walk-in clinics and rehabilitation facilities provide an opportunity for individuals to be exposed to a variety of germs. As a result, we are asking that non-essential medical appointments be re-scheduled. Individuals who need to be seen at a physician's office, the hospital, walk-in clinic and/or who are returning from an inpatient rehabilitation stay will be asked to self-quarantine. The Nurses will provide guidelines pertaining to lengths of time and steps that will be implemented. These measures are in place to help to stop the spread of germs in the facility and for the safety of all the Seasons residents and staff. As always, we will continue to update you as we receive additional information and guidance from the Rhode Island Department of Health. If you should have questions, we ask that you speak directly to a nurse.
